To inseminate the following mare, for which a copy of registration papers will be provided by the Mare Owner:

Subject to the following conditions:

1. For mares in Miner Institute's care: Mare Owner will provide Miner Institute with a statement signed by a licensed veterinarian certifying that the mare named is in good physical health, free from infectious disease, and is in sound reproductive condition. Mares will be currently immunized, dewormed, and have a negative Coggins Test within 12 months.
2. The stallion service fee is \$DONATION TO THE NYSMHS SSA.
3. Mare Owners requesting shipped live-cooled semen must pay \$350.00 per collection and shipment of semen (Collection fee, disposable shipping container and FedEx fees). Semen can be collected Monday through Friday, with the exception of

federal holidays, notification by 9:00 a.m. EST. *Miner Institute is unable to ship via airlines counter to counter service.*

4. Mares bred “on-farm” will be bred via artificial insemination by experienced personnel. Board of mares is \$10/day or \$15/day with foal at side. Semen collection fee for mares bred “on-farm” is \$150.00. Mares boarding at Miner Institute must pay a deposit of \$200.00 which will be credited to the final invoice or the difference will be refunded.

5. Miner Institute will care for mare or mare and foal in a diligent manner and reserves the right to employ veterinary or farrier care at owner’s expense for ultrasounds, uterine treatments, illness or injury. Owner agrees that Miner Institute and its employees will not be held responsible or liable for accident, injury, sickness or death to mare or mare and/or foal whether bred at Miner Institute or via transported live-cooled semen.

6. If mare fails to conceive after three heat cycles, Miner Institute offers the following options:

- A. Mare Owner should have the mare evaluated for reproductive health including uterine culture, biopsy or other diagnostic procedures before proceeding with further breeding.
- B. Miner Institute may allow a substitute mare.

7. Mare Owner agrees to have the mare examined by a licensed veterinarian between 40-60 days from the last insemination and to notify Miner Institute of her pregnancy status at that time.

8. Should the stallion die or become unfit for service, Mare Owner may choose an alternate Miner Institute stallion if available.

9. Mare Owner agrees to update the Mare’s ownership via the American Morgan Horse Association Registry and subsequently register the resulting foal.

10. Any disputes arising out of this contract shall be settled under the Laws of the State of New York.
